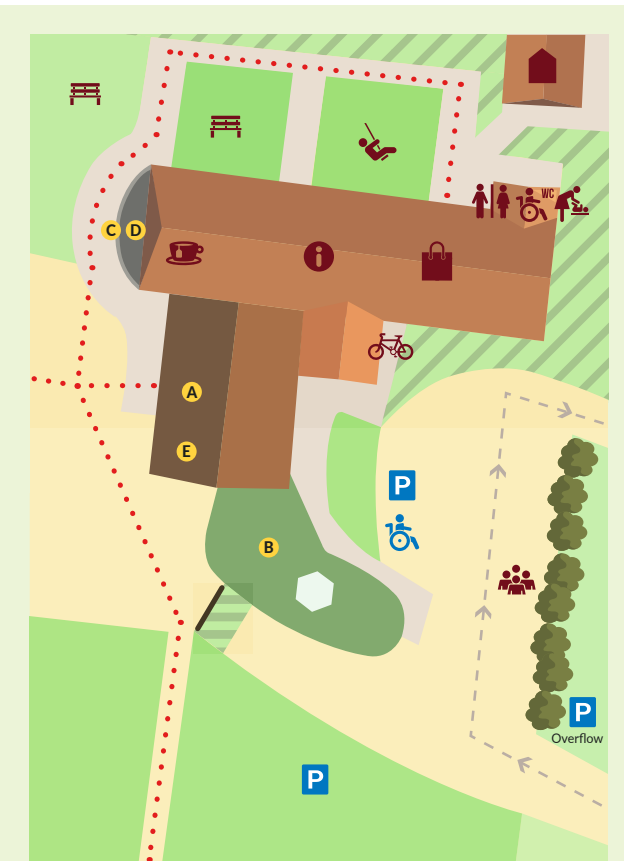

Our wildlife

Red says...

- Don't feed the horses – they much prefer cuddles!
- Wash your hands after touching our horses
- Keep two feet on the ground – **no climbing** on paddock fences or stable doors
- Keep **dogs on leads** – some horses may be nervous of your four-legged friend
- Ensure **under 16s** are always accompanied and **supervised by an adult**

Redwings is the largest horse sanctuary in the UK, which means we care for more horses each day than anyone else.

Rescue

We rescue approximately 150 horses every year who have been abandoned, neglected or whose owners can no longer care for them.

Rehabilitation

Many horses are unhandled and nervous when they first come to Redwings. Our expert behaviour team helps them to trust humans.

Care

Our care team and vets look after over 1,500 horses every day at the Sanctuary, many of whom have very special needs.

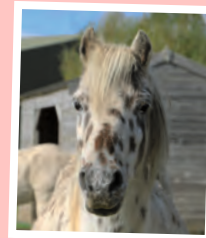
Rehoming

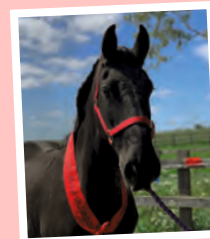


Cookie

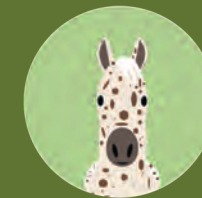

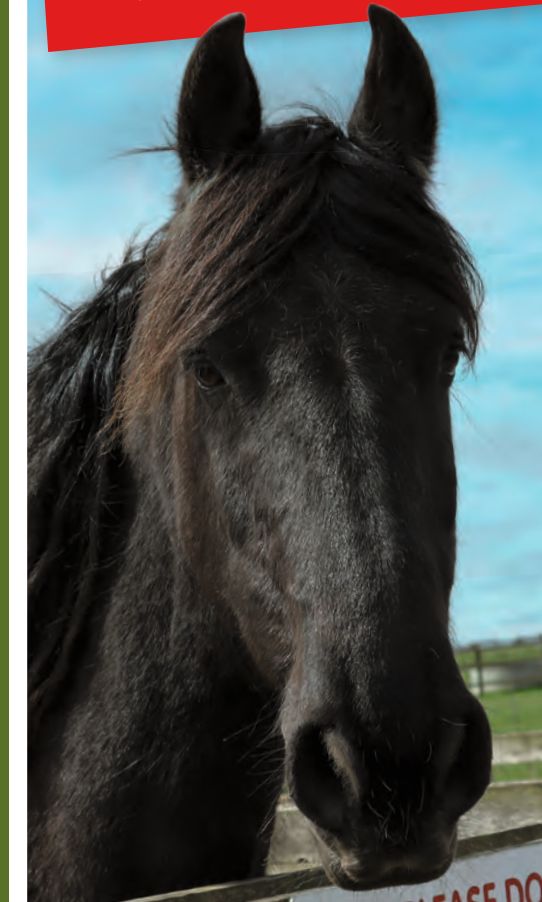


Redwings Oxhill, Warwickshire
