We rescue approximately 1,500 horses every year who have been abandoned, neglected or whose owners can no longer care for them.

Our care team and vets look after over 1,500 horses every day at the Sanctuary, many of whom have very special needs.

Fox - otherwise known as Four Four Sees - is a Black Shire Cross who arrived at Redwings in 2010 when he was just a few months old.

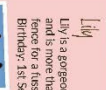

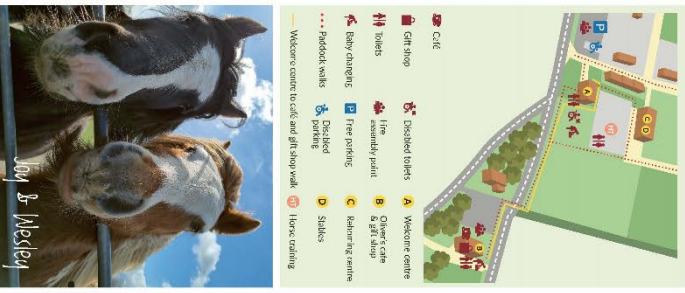
Red says...

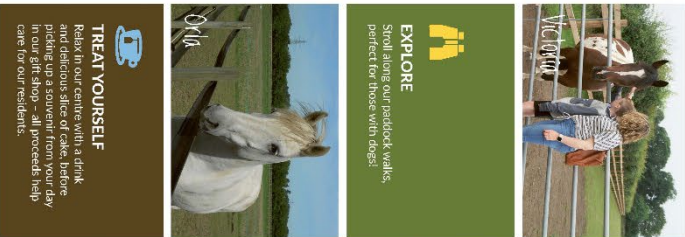
